



## **Motion to Increase the Number of Gender Neutral Loos at the University of Suffolk**

### **The Students' Union Notes**

University of Suffolk's Student Union notes that there is a lack of gender-neutral toilets available at the University of Suffolk, and that these reside in only 2 buildings of 5. As the transgender and non-binary population at the university grows, it is unsustainable for the University to only have gender neutral bathrooms in two of their buildings.

### **The Students' Union Believes**

University of Suffolk's Student Union believes that all students have the right to have access to a bathroom on campus, and that the current bathroom situation at the University of Suffolk is unfair on those students who need access to a gender-neutral bathroom.

### **The Students' Union Resolves**

University of Suffolk's Student Union resolves that the sabbatical officers work with Estates and other relevant teams to increase the number of gender-neutral toilets available on campus – disabled toilets should not be used for this purpose. This means that there should be at least 5 – one in each building – with it being preferable that there is one on each floor of each building where possible.
