The Students' Union notes

That conversion therapy is a damaging process that disproportionately affects the LGBTQ+ community, and that it is currently not banned within the UK. Although there are proposed laws which would ban some aspects of conversion therapy, there are concerns that these will not cover the full community without support from organisations such as the SU.

The Students' Union believes

That no one should go through the process of conversion therapy as it is damaging to the individual who goes through it, and that there is no safe version of conversion therapy.

The Students' Union resolves

That they will release a statement in support of banning all types of conversion therapy and that they will support any students who are finding this discussion difficult. In addition, the SU will help to support those who have had negative experiences with or surrounding conversion therapy.
